

# ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURE 201

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## LIFE MEMBERSHIP

### Background

In accordance with Article III, Memberships, Section 2, STAA By-Laws, the Executive Committee may elect to bestow a Life Membership to an individual.

### Guidelines and Procedures

1. A Life Membership may be bestowed on any member from within STAA.
2. A Life Membership may be bestowed to an individual who has been a STAA member for at least 10 years and has served at least one term on the STAA Executive Committee.
3. Life Members are exempt from paying dues.
4. The Executive Committee may elect to bestow a Life Membership for other considerations. A motion approving the Life Time Membership would be required by the Executive.
5. Any Member may put forward a name for special consideration of the Executive.
6. A Life Membership is a symbolic gesture and does not entitle the Life Member to the same rights and privileges afforded to regular members.
7. Life Members are entitled to:
  - 7.1 Attend Annual General Meeting
  - 7.2 Attend Zone Meetings
  - 7.3 Attend Supervisors' Meetings
  - 7.4 Attend Executive Committee Meetings
  - 7.5 Request information through the Executive Director
8. Life Members are not entitled to:
  - 8.1 Vote on STAA matters or hold office
  - 8.2 Have STAA web site member access
  - 8.3 Receive Highlights/minutes
  - 8.4 Be on the STAA email distribution list

Administrative Procedure 201 – continued

9. Recognition of a Life Members may consist of:
  - 9.1 An Alberta Award
  - 9.2 A letter outlining privileges and limitations
  - 9.3 Paid registration at that year's convention (ASTAC provides)
  - 9.4 An invitation to a banquet or luncheon for themselves and one guest
  - 9.5 One night's accommodation if required
  
10. The current/outgoing President will ensure speeches are prepared and given to the award recipients.
